- I. 50% of the total seats including the seats reserved for SC/ST/SEBC/EWS will be filled up through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) by the University. Please refer University CAP website <a href="http://www.cuonline.ac.in">(http://www.cuonline.ac.in</a>) for more information.
- II. Students admitted through CAP of the University and to the 50% seats filled by the College should pay the same fees as described in para 6
- 3. Before applying online for admission to 50% of seats to be filled by IHRD Colleges, the candidate should have completed online registration at University of Calicut CAP admission portal.
- 4 The eligibility/selection/assessment of merit of the applicant will be as per the University rules prevailing from time to time and will be final and binding.
- 5. There are no management quota seats in Colleges of Applied Science managed by IHRD.



1. Those candidates who are "Eligible for Higher Studies" as per the Higher Secondary Examination or a pass in the equivalent examination is the minimum criteria for admission to undergraduate programmes, unless otherwise specified. All Candidates qualified in the annual examination held upto and including the preceding academic years are eligibile for admission. However, candidates who have qualified the HSE and VHSE of the Government of Kerala under 'SAY' scheme and Compartmental Examination of CBSE are also eligible for admission tofirst year undergraduate programmes in the same academic year. (*U.O.No GAI/A2/5753/2000 dated 14.05.2004*). The Candidates possessing certificates with "Eligible for Higher Studies" issued by the Kerala State Literacy Mission Authority are also eligible for Humanities and Commerce Programmes. (U.O. No.408/2019/Admn Dated:11.01.2019). Afsal – Ul- Ulama preliminary course conducted by the University of Calicut is equivalent to the Plus Two Course in Humanities of Higher Secondary Board of Government of Kerala. (GO (Rt).no.2165/2014H.Edn Dated:03.06.2014 & U.O.No.8883/2015/Admn Dated:8.08.2015).

2. The blind students are not eligible for admission in Science subjects (Except BSc Computer Seince, IT and BCA) involving practical. Deaf and hard of hearing students are not eligible for reservation in Science subjects (Except BSc Computer Seince / BSc IT/BCA/BSc Mathematics-U.O.No. 4615/2021/Admn, Dated 19.04.2021, involving practical.

#### Equivalency /Recognition

Equivalency / Recognition of the qualifying examinations taken from other Universities/ Institutions should be confirmed strictly before making admission of students, except in the case of HSE / VHSE of the Kerala State Board and all regular Higher Secondary Examinations conducted by other State Boards, AISSCE (XII std.) of CBSE, ISCE and NIOS candidates who have passed the course with a minimum of five subjects, out of which one should be English.

#### No Private/self-study facility for Common Courses

Regular students who are admitted to the UG programmes under CBCSS UG 2019 scheme, have to choose any one of the additional languages (Common Course) offered by the college. The existing regulations under the CBCSS UG 2019 scheme, does not permit self-study of additional language, which is not offered by the college. (Circular No. 56892/GA-IV–J2/2019/Admn, dated 09.04.2021)

### B Com (Computer Applications/Finance)

Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with at least one commerce subject are eligible for admissions to the B Com degree course.

Candidates who have not studied commerce subject for Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination not less than 45% marks are also eligible. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass. (U.O. No.GAI/A2/1658/2007 dated 28.02.2008).

**Index Mark:** Total marks + 25 marks for each commerce papers subject to maximum of 50 marks. COMMERCE PAPERS Accountancy/ Accountancy and Auditing/ Accountancy with AFS/ Accountancy with Computer Accounting/ Accountancy (Analysis of Financial Statements)/ Accountancy (computerized accounting)/ Accounts/ Banking Assistance/ Banking with Secretarial Practice/ Book Keeping and Accountancy/ Book-Keeping & Basic Mathematics/ Book-Kpng & Accountancy/ Business Studies/ Business Studies with Functional Management/ Business Mathematics/ Catering and Restaurant Management/ Commerce/ Commercial Correspondence and Commercial Geography/ Commercial Geography & Commercial Correspondence/ General insurance/ Management/ Marketing/ Marketing and Salesmanship/ Office Secretary ship/ Reception, Book Keeping and Communication

**Tie Break:** If there is a tie in the index marks, those who studied commerce in the Plus Two or equivalent get preference. If there is tie again, the marks in the commerce subjects will be considered first, then the marks of English and then the marks of Additional language/second language will be considered. Finally general conditions are applicable.

#### B C A (Bachelor of Computer Application)

Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with Mathematics/ Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Additional Mathematics as one of the subjects are eligible for admissions (U.O. No.GAI/J1/2453/1997 dated o6.10.2000 and GA I/J1/1597/2005 dated 11.07.2005).

Index Mark: Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics in the case of Science group with Mathematics as one of the subject AND Total Part III + marks secured for Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics/ Computer Information Technology in the case of other combinations without Mathematics as one of the subject. If the Candidates has studied both Mathematics and any one of the following subjects Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Informatics then the marks secured for Mathematics or Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology whichever is higher will be added

**Tie Break:** If there is a tie in the index marks priority must be given to Mathematics/Computer Science as the case may be. If there is a tie again, the marks of the second subsidiary and marks of English and then the marks for additional language/second language after general conditions.

#### B A English Language and Literature

Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission.

**Index Mark:** Total Marks + Twice the marks secured in English. A weightage of 20 marks will be given to those who have studies English, and Communicative English as optional subject for HSE or an equivalent examination.

**Tie Break**: If there is a tie in the ranking, the priority will be given to those who got more marks in English. If there is again a tie, marks in second language are considered and then the general conditions are applicable.

#### B B A. (Bachelor of Business Administration)

Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto, with not less than 45% is eligible for admissions. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass.

Index Mark: Total marks + 25 marks for each commerce papers subject to a maximum of 50 marks. Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with Mathematics group only are eligible for admission to B Sc.Mathematics.

**Index Mark:** Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for the Mathematics

**Tie Break:** If there is tie priority must be given to the candidates who secured more marks in the main subject concerned. If there is a tie again the marks of compulsory subsidiary subjects and then the marks obtained for the second subsidiary subject are too considered. Even after there is tie the marks obtained in English, the second language are considered and at last general conditions are applied.

Any changes to the above eligibility/indexing rules announced by the University even after publishing of the Prospectus will be binding in the process of Admissions to all the above courses

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

Candidates have to submit duly filled up online application at the portal <a href="http://www.ihrdadmissions.org">http://www.ihrdadmissions.org</a> The College, on the basis of merit as given below, will prepare rank list.

#### ASSESSMENT OF MERIT

The Marks obtained in the Plus Two examinations is taken in to account and the index mark is calculated by following the UO No. GA1/A2/1658/2007 dated 28.02.2008. The merit of the candidate will be assessed and rank list prepared on the basis of the index mark for admission to the particular programme.

#### **BONUS / WEIGHTAGE MARKS**

Bonus / weightage marks will be added to the total marks obtained in the qualifying examination to calculate the index marks and for ranking in the selection list in the case of candidates who already possess the required minimum marks prescribed.

- 7. The benefit of bonus marks for the purpose of admission can be availed of by the candidates only under any one category, from 3 to 6.
- 8. The applicant need to produce the relevant certificate in original for claiming the bonus mark at the time of admission.

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. The admission of the students who obtained the same index marks shall be decided first on the basis of age and then by name in alphabetical order unless otherwise specified. (U.O. No. GA1/A2/7226/200 dated 04-05-2001)
- 2. In the case of VHSE candidates for admissions to B Com/B B A programmes and all other programmes that come under Commerce and Management faculty, the index marks shall be arrived at by taking the marks of all the subjects except that of the marks of Vocational practical and Internship Evaluation. (U.O. No.2422/2015 dated 11.03.2015).
- 3. In the case of VHSE candidates for admissions to BCom/B B A/BTHM programmes and all other programmes that come under Commerce and Management faculty, the index marks shall be arrived at by taking the marks of all the subjects except that of the marks of Vocational practical and Internship Evaluation. (U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated: 11.03.2015).
- 4. In the case of courses equivalent to Plus two of Kerala HSE and have maximum marks or grades not in line with that of Plus two of Kerala HSE, the same will be normalized to the maximum marks of Plus two of Kerala HSE and the rank list will be prepared accordingly.(U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated :11.03.2015).
- 5. For admissions to B A programmes, the existing weightage of 25 marks shall be increased to 50, for those who have studied the subject concerned (mentioned in the present admission rule) in HSE or equivalent. (U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated: 11.03.2015).

#### Note

- 1. The College of applied science are managed by IHRD, a Govt. of Kerala undertaking. Admissions for all seats are made purely on the basis of merit and strictly as per Govt. /University rules. Canvassing in any form is illegal and strictly prohibited
- 2. The mode of selection has been revised as per order U.O.No: 1632/2013 CU dated 15.05.2013 of the University of Calicut.
- 3. The selection of candidates for admission will be on the basis of information furnished by the candidate in his/her application. The online application form should be filled up carefully and ranking will be based on the information provided by the candidate. Incomplete applications will be rejected without any intimation.



### **RESERVATION**

(THSS Reservation and Local Reservation are provided to 50% of seats allocated for admission directly by the colleges as per the following guidelines)


#### THSS RESERVATION

15% of the seats allocated to IHRD Colleges for B Sc. Computer Science, B Sc. Electronics and B C A are reserved for the candidates who have passed the THSS examination from the Technical Higher Secondary Schools managed by IHRD.

#### LOCAL RESERVATION

20% of the seats allocated to IHRD (for B Sc. Electronics & B Sc. Computer Science only) at College of Applied Science at Vadakkencherry is reserved for local candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from educational institutions situated within the territorial limit of Vadakkencherry, Kizhakkencherry, Vandazhy, Kannambra and Puthukode Grama Panchayat areas.

Reservation of seats under the quota of Union Territory of Lakshadweep/Kashmiri Students/Andaman & Nicobar/Sports quota/mentally challenged / Inmates in Juvenile Justice Centres will be filled as per University norms. They will have to submit their applications to the College with the caption "Application under <Category name>" on the top of the Application form. Candidates applying under Sports quota category should submit a copy of the Application to the corresponding District Sports council too. The selection to sports Quota will be based on the rank list submitted by the corresponding District sports councils.



#### **APPLICATION ONLINE**

Application for admission to various degree courses in Colleges of Applied Science against seats allotted to IHRD colleges for direct admission is to be submitted online through the website of IHRD <a href="http://www.ihrdadmissions.org">http://www.ihrdadmissions.org</a> The print out of the online application along with the details of remittance of required registration fee and copies of certificates should be submitted to the Principal of concerned colleges before the last date of submission of online application\*. Separate print out of application should be submitted for admission to each College of Applied Science under IHRD.

Before applying online for admission to seats filled by Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD directly, the candidate should have completed the online registration at the University of Calicut CAP admission portal.

## SINGLE WINDOW APPLICATION REGISTRATION FEE

The application Registration fee will be Rs 750/- (Rs.250/- for SC/ST candidates). Students will be able to give options to all the colleges of IHRD under Calicut University through single registration and payment. The application registration fee payment will be accepted only through SBI Collect as per details in the IHRD admission portal. Application Registration fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances. The details of application Registration fee remitted should be entered in the admission portal while submitting the online application also. Applications without application Registration fee will be summarily rejected.

#### SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

The print out taken after submitting online application along with supporting documents shall be submitted to the Principal of concerned College of Applied Science (Please see para 1, for the address for communication of the College of Applied Sciences) before the last date of submission of online application.\* Late/incomplete applications/applications not in the prescribed form/applications without supporting documents/application registration fee will be summarily rejected.

A candidate can submit application for admission to Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD directly also if online submission of application is not possible. The candidate may download the application form from the IHRD website www.ihrd.ac.in and filled in application form along with proof of remittance of Application Registration fee may be sent by post to reach the office of the Principal, College of Applied Science where the candidate wishes to get admitted before the last date of submission of online applications fixed by the University of Calicut. In such case Application Registration fee may be paid through DD taken in favour of the Principal of the concerned College of Applied Science.

## DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH PRINT OUT OF THE ONLINE APPLICATION

- 1. Self-attested copy of the SSLC/equivalent certificate to prove the Date of Birth of the applicant.
- 2. Self-attested copy of the mark list of the HSE or equivalent.
- 3. Self-attested copy of relevant certificate issued by competent authority for claiming weightage for N S S, N CC, Exservice men dependency.
- 4. Self-attested copy of Transfer Certificate/Course Certificate for claiming THSS reservation.

#### FEE REMITTANCE SCHEDULE\*

First Semester fee should be paid at the time of admission and Semester fee for all the remaining Semesters should be paid at the beginning of each semester.

(\*The principals of respective colleges of Applied science are allowed to make changes in the fee remittance schedule for deserving cases if necessary)

#### Note

- 1. In addition, the student will have to remit the University affiliation/administration and other mandatory fees as required by the University from time to time, including University Examination fee.
- 2. The PTA fee, Magazine, Association fees as recommended by the College concerned should be remitted at the time of admission.

#### **FEE CONCESSION**

- 1. SC/ST/OEC candidates and any other category as directed by the Govt. /University will be exempted from payment of the prescribed fee on the condition that they will submit the application for educational concession to the SC/ST Development Department in the prescribed form along with supporting documents within 15 days from the date of admission. If they fail to do so, or if educational concession is not sanctioned by the SC/ST Development Department, the student is liable to remit the entire fee.
- 2. All students including those eligible for any type of Educational Concession from various Departments/Welfare Agencies, other than the SC/ST/OEC or any other category as prescribed by the Govt. from time to time should remit the entire fee as per schedule. But the due amount sanctioned towards the educational concession to the eligible students by the Department/ Welfare agencies will be reimbursed to them by the Principal, as and when it is received in the institution.

### RULES FOR ISSUE OF TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

- If any student who got admitted to Degree programmes later discontinues his/her study from any one of the College of Applied Science, managed by IHRD, TC will be issued as per conditions specified in the G.O.(MS)no. 319/2017/H.Edn.(J) dated 29-12-2017. i.e. In the event of a student leaving before the starting of the course, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of processing fee of Rs.1,000/ (Rupees One thousand only) will be refunded by the College. If a student leaves after joining the course (after the date of commencement of classes) and if the vacated seat is consequently filled by another student by the last date of admission, the College will refund the fee collected after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs. 1,000/ (Rupees One thousand only) and proportionate deductions of monthly fee and other applicable fees. In case the vacated seat is not filled, the candidate is eligible to get refund of the Caution deposit only. All such refund will be processed only after closure of Degree admission 2022- 23 by the University. Fee for the candidates getting admission in any of the other Colleges of Applied Science, managed by IHRD, during the same admission year will be adjusted after deducting the admission fee.
- 2. In case of Inter College transfer between Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD within the same University and programme after the date of closure of admission, TC will be issued on payment of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) towards processing fee. In such cases, the applicant is eligible to get refund of 75% of the tuition fee through inter institutional transfer only.
- 3. If a student applies for TC to join Higher Option allotted by the University Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) for the UG admission of the University, the TC and other documents will be issued as per the University guidelines in time to time.

The rules 1,2&3 above are applicable for all students admitted, including those admitted through Centralized Admission Process of University of Calicut.



### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Receipt of application will be acknowledged, allotting a registration number. The registration number as shown in the receipt should be mentioned in all future correspondence concerning admission.
- 2. Selection of candidates will be made by the Principals concerned, based on the information furnished in the application
- 3. The selection for admission will be provisional subject to verification of original documents and approval of University. If on verification any information given in the application is found to be false or the University rejects the admission due to any other reason, the candidates will forfeit his/her claim for admission.
- 4. The list of candidates called for interview and the interview schedule will be published concerned college notice board, and/or the concerned College website. **Selection memo will be sent by email only. Hence providing valid email-id and a contact telephone number is mandatory.** It will be mandatory for the candidates to check their position from the list published in the institution/website and appear for the interview.
- 5. The candidates called for interview should bring the originals of all the certificates on the dates specified.
- 6. A candidate who does not turn up for the interview as per the schedule at the place and time will forfeit his/her chance for admission and will not be considered for any future vacancies for admission irrespective of the rank secured. However, if a candidate is not able to attend the interview on genuine grounds, the parent / guardian or any authorized person can act as a proxy at the risk of the candidate.
- 7. The candidate seeking admission to UG courses will have to abide by the campus rules and regulations issued from time to time. The campus rules now in force in the institutions under IHRD are given below.
  - No student will be permitted to enter the campus without being in proper uniform. The Uniform prescribed for UG follows. the students Girls: Pajama, White black shoes. Boys: White Grey Grey overcoat and Half Sleeve Shirt, Grey Pants with black shoes. \*(Jeans and low waist pants/Jeans are strictly prohibited)
  - *II*. Use of motorized vehicles by students with in the campus is strictly prohibited. In any case, no personal

conveyance other than bicycle will be allowed within the campus.

- III. Consumption of Alcohol, Drugs and Smoking is strictly prohibited within the campus. Strict disciplinary action including dismissal will be taken against students if found guilty.
- *IV.* Students are requested to co-operate to maintain the building and the campus clean and spotless, as well as to keep the furniture, laboratory equipment and other institute properties without loss ordamage.
- **V.** The identity card issued by the Institute must be prominently displayed on the chest by each student. Mere possession of the card is not enough.
- **VI.** Directions of the Principal and other staff in respect of academic matters and general discipline must be strictly complied with by all students.
- **VII.** Leave of absence will be granted only on medical grounds. However, such leave will be considered only for the purpose of granting condonation of shortage of attendance.
- VIII. Hostel facilities are not provided by the Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD and hence the students will have to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging.
- *IX.* Use of mobile phones, performance of cinematic dance and fashion shows are strictly prohibited in the campus as per Govt. rules.
- **X.** The head of institution is empowered to take appropriate disciplinary action including dismissal from the institution, against students found guilty as per campus rules.

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# PREVENTION OF RAGGING IN CAMPUS

## RAGGING IS A COGNISABLE OFFENCE AND PUNISHABLE UNDER PROVISIONS OF KERALA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT. 1998.

Ragging within or outside this educational institution is prohibited. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within, or outside, this educational institution, shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extent to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees. Any student convicted of an offense under this act shall also be dismissed from this educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of three years from the date of order of such dismissal.
