

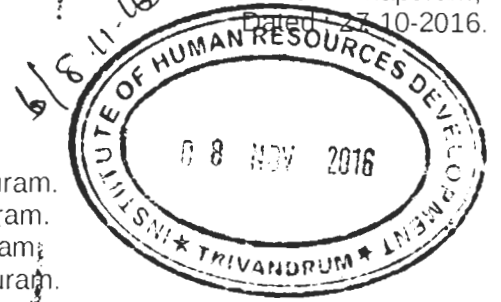

Dear Sir,

Kindly refer to my D.O. letter No.16-8/2015-U.5 dated 19th August, 2015 regarding compliance in accordance with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 8th May, 2009 (in Civil Appeal No.887 of 2009) in the matter of University of Kerala Vs. Councils, Principals, Colleges, Kerala, and others. Copy of the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is available on www.courtncic.nic.in/courtncisc.asp.

2. In this regard, you are kindly requested to direct the concerned authorities at the District level to comply with the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by way of:

- participating in anti-ragging Committees of educational institutions
- constituting district level Anti-Ragging committees to be headed by Dy. Commissioner/District Magistrate
- keeping vigil on incidents of ragging, taking immediate action on receiving distress message from victims of ragging.

3. You are also requested to kindly take action regarding the following:-

- appointing State level committees to examine the problems of alcoholism on the campuses and to suggest immediate de-addiction measures
- setting up a State level Committee to study the psychological impact of ragging on students and take urgent and mandatory measures to prevent ragging in educational institutions
- taking e-governance initiatives, e.g. anti-ragging mobile app to check incidents of ragging or eve teasing.

4. You will also appreciate that there has to be a sustained awareness campaign against ragging, especially through advertisements, throughout the academic year. The State Government may, therefore, consider advising educational institutions in the State to give wide publicity against ragging.

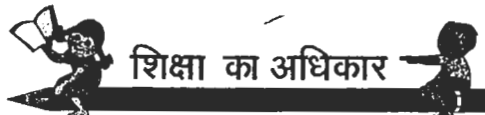
